## Application and Reasoning Past and Present Tense 1

### Developing

- 1a. Tamara has changed 'need' into its 3rd person present form 'needs'. She should have changed 'need' to 'needed'.  
2a. I fill the cup.  
3a. Simple past tense. The verb 'own' is in its past tense form 'owned'.

### Expected

- 4a. Sunil has turned 'came' into the form it would take if 'come' was a regular verb. He should have changed 'came' to 'come'.  
5a. A. Past to present tense: I find some treasure and share it with my friends.  
B. Present to past tense: I began to learn dinosaur facts and enjoyed myself.  
6a. This is present tense because 'throws' and 'misses' are present tense forms of 'throw' and 'miss'.

### Greater Depth

- 7a. Emily has treated 'go' as a regular verb when it is irregular. She should have changed 'go' to 'went'.  
8a. A. Present to past tense: When I shook the branch, you caught the apples that fell.  
B. Past to present tense: The plumber tears his pants that he catches on a nail.  
9a. This is past tense because although 'read' is both the past and present tense form, 'sought' is the past tense of 'seek'.

## Application and Reasoning Past and Present Tense 1

### Developing

- 1b. Jake has only taken away the 'd' from the end of 'pulled' when he should have taken away the 'ed' to make 'pull'.  
2b. The egg cracked open.  
3b. Simple present tense. The verb 'peel' is in its present tense form.

### Expected

- 4b. Sadia has added 'ed' to the end of 'care' when she should only have added 'd' to make 'cared' because 'care' ends in an 'e'.  
5b. A. Past to present tense: He steals the jewels but triggers the alarm.  
B. Present to past tense: Tori gazed out of the window and saw a robin on the grass.  
6b. This is past tense because 'scraped' and 'rode' are the past tense forms of 'scrape' and 'ride'.

### Greater Depth

- 7b. Jinder has used an incorrect transformation of the irregular verb 'buy'. He should have changed 'buy' to 'bought', rather than adding a 't' to the end of the word.  
8b. A. Past to present tense: I withdraw some money because I need some change for the carpark.  
B. Present to past tense: I bore the weight of the wood as Jon spread the paint.  
9b. It is impossible to tell. The verbs are both irregular verbs which take the same form in both present and past tense. A sufficient explanation for past, present or 'could be either' should be accepted.
