Dear Parents/Guardians.

On Tuesday 26th March, Year 2 will be visiting Snaefell Mountain to apply our themed learning of Mountains and Mountain Ranges. We will be walking to Derby Castle tram station, travelling by tram to Laxey tram station and then up Snaefell Mountain.

Once at the top of the mountain the children will take part in group and independent activities, such as sketching, a scavenger hunt and enjoying their packed lunch with a view! After exploring Snaefell Mountain, we will be walking down to Laxey Beach to explore more of the surrounding area of Snaefell.

The trip will take place during the school day, therefore the children will need to be dropped off and picked up from school at the normal times and places.

Children need to wear their own clothes and footwear appropriate for a day outside. Please be advised that the trip will go ahead in any weather, so please provide a waterproof jacket.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch in a labelled, disposable bag. Please do not send in juice or fizzy drinks, sweets or products containing nuts. If your child normally receives a free school meal and you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch please indicate this via Parent Pay.

The cost of this trip is £8 per child (cost of travelling on the tram). The OSA are kindly subsidising the trip and are paying £3 per child therefore we are asking for a £5 contribution from you. The children will not need any extra money on the trip. Payment for this trip is via Parent Pay only.
