Reminders:

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Spring 1 Focus:

This half term, we are focusing on the Tudor Dynasty. This will include important people and events as the children produce diary entries, explore the lives of Kings and Queens and create Tudor family trees with portraits. At the end of the half term, we will be having a Tudor Day. This will include coming to school dressed as Tudors, exploring Tudor dancing and sport and designing our own Tudor houses.

Spring 2 Focus:

In Topic this half term, our focus will be on Tectonics. This will include Tectonic plates, the continents and natural disasters such as volcanoes, earthquakes and hurricanes. Children will create their own exploding volcanoes, learn about natural disasters and design natural disaster defences. This will link with our literacy book 'Escape from Pompeii' and our maps skills learning.
