Clothing

Year Four Learning Information

150th Anniversary at Onchan Primary School

This term, our school is exploring its exciting history while also looking ahead to the future. These themes will be integrated across the curriculum through various projects and school trips. A key focus will be collaboration between different year groups, allowing students to work together and share perspectives as they learn about the school's heritage and its next era!

Home learning

Home learning will continue to be focused on reading, spelling and Mathletics. All the children will be familiar with their class pages and how to access them using their log ins.

Teams- We will continue to use Teams to share resources with the children, for use both in the classroom and at home to consolidate learning.

Reading – Within class the children take part in a Whole Class Reading approach. We will explore extracts from a range of texts. The children have a reading journal to continue practicing their reading and comprehension skills at home.

Spellings/Times Tables/Mathletics – Weekly spellings and times tables practice take place within class. However, it is essential that the children continue to consolidate these at home. As teachers we will be monitoring their achievements on Spelling Shed, Mathletics and TT Rockstars.

Reading Journal

The children each have a Reading Journal to record when they read and complete challenges in. Each half term, the children are set activities to complete.
