## Top Tips to make children's devices safer

1. Make search engines safer by using 'safe search setting' and remember to save it.
2. Disable location software.
3. Be mindful of suitable screen time for your child.
4. Set a pin on individual devices to maximise control of each device.
5. On Apple devices you can visit settings then general for 'restrictions'.
6. On Android devices you can select restrictions through a Google account.
7. On Android smartphone you can select parental controls in the play store.

## Setting up new software

- Check a games spec before buying especially for PC or Mac.
- Check age ratings when purchasing the app online.
- Check how much storage the software needs and check the devices storage availability.
- Be wary of gifts which can be earned through games.
- Be careful of costs after downloading different games. Even applications free to download have additional charges when playing (make sure children can't make purchases themselves).
- Be aware of gifts which can be earned in the game (there maybe hidden costs).
- Keep a check on voice chat in apps to prevent children speaking to strangers during games.
