## Welcome to Year 6!

We are very excited to be welcoming your child into Year 6 and creating lots of fun, exciting memories in their last year of primary school.

#### Autumn Term Learning Focus

In Literacy, during Autumn Term 1 we are focusing on texts connected to Migration and Movement, 'The Arrival' and 'Windrush Child'. During Autumn 2, the texts will focus on Evolution and Inheritance, 'Can We Save the Tiger?' and 'The Last Bear'.

In Maths we will begin by focusing on Place Value, focusing on numbers up to 10 million. We will then recap addition, subtraction, multiplication and division before progressing onto fractions.

Please encourage your child to practice their times tables at home to support their learning in school. Whiterose Home Learning videos are a fantastic resource to revisit the learning completed in class.

In Topic we are going to be focusing our learning on 'Slavery and Empire' and 'Climate change & global awareness'.

Throughout Year 6, the children the have the opportunity to participate in different transition events to prepare them for the move to Secondary School. This half term, Mrs Temple will be joining the Year 6 children at Onchan to begin music lessons.
