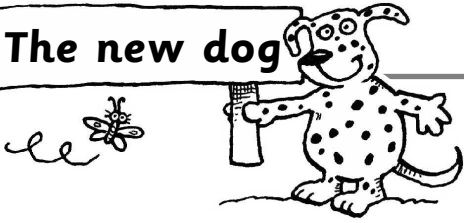

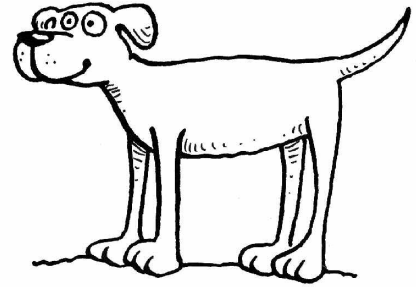

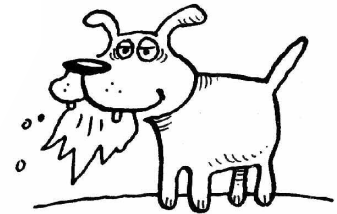

Notes for teachers

For the first question pupils are required to write a simple sentence for their answer e.g. 'Tara and Al wanted a dog'. If appropriate, you could dictate this answer for the children to write, encouraging them to use their phonic skills to segment the words for spelling. For the final task, discuss the sorts of dogs that pupils might like and how the type of dog they choose might vary depending on their circumstances e.g. a small dog is better suited to city life.
