National Curriculum Objectives:

English Year 1: Understand both the books they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to by checking that the text makes sense to them as they read, and correcting inaccurate reading

English Year 2: Understand both the books that they can already read accurately and fluently and those that they listen to by checking that the text makes sense to them as they read, and correcting inaccurate reading

Differentiation:

Beginner Includes 3 different text types (narrative, diary extract and instructions) followed by questions requiring children to identify 6 true or false statements using information from the text. Aimed at Year 1 Secure.

Easy Includes 3 different text types (narrative, diary extract and instructions) followed by questions requiring children to identify 8 true or false statements using information from the text. Aimed at Year 2 Developing.

Tricky Includes 4 different text types (narrative, diary extract, instructions and a non-chronological report) followed by questions requiring children to identify 10 true or false statements using information from the text. Aimed at Year 2 Secure.

Young Rabbits

A young rabbit is called a kit, which is short for kitten. Rabbits are born with their eyes closed and with no fur. Most female rabbits give birth to a litter of 6 kits at a time. There can be as many as 14 kits in a litter and a female rabbit can have as many as 12 litters a year! Rabbits usually live to the age of 10.

Diet

Rabbits are herbivores. This means that they eat plants. During the summer months, rabbits eat weeds, grass, clovers, flowers and vegetables. During the winter months, rabbits have to chew on bark, twigs and any remaining green plants.
