Look at some of his paintings. What do you see in them? How do they make you feel? Look at how many different shades he has used.	<p><i>Skill: Children to be aware how to mix secondary colours + awareness of shades. (How to make darker and lighter.</i></p> <p>Children to practice mixing primary and secondary colours on a colour wheel. Also, to make shades lighter and darker. Finally, children to reproduce the "Concentric Circles" painting using colours and shades of their choice. Us A3 paper divided into 12 different areas. Can the children describe how the painting makes them feel?</p>
