Art Planning: Famous Artists

Aim: To develop an awareness of the lives of significant artists and copy some of their methods to improve their own art.



	Teacher Input	Activity	
Week 3	Manx week. Children to look at Archibald Knox. See information sheet about his life. (If time, as it's Manx week! - Children to also make a clay Celtic cross and push in imprints of Celtic patterns. Children roll a ball of clay flat (to 1/2 cm thick) with a rolling pin and use ruler to cut two pieces ruler wide 15 cms long + 5 cms long approx. Place on top of each other and mould together with cross hatching method and water + smoothing with fingers Push in Celtic pattern from book mark/ brooch. Dry and paint with PVA.	Skill: Children to have experience with 3D modelling. Exposure to different art mediums (paper mache/ clay) Children to make a paper mache bowl with Archibald Knox design in the middle. Method: Line a plastic bowl with silver foil and then add - 4 layers of newspaper squares and one layer of white paper squares. Use watered down PVA as the glue (1/3 PVA to 2/3 water) Put a silver brooch design in the middle. After the bowel has dried, trim the edges and paint the inside with PVA glue. See example
