Solve



Endeavour made twenty five voyages in its life time. The maximum crew it could carry each time was seven. How many crew would there have been in total if it had been full each time?

Challenge: If one fifth of the voyages had only six crew members, how many crew members would there have been in total?

Discover



Fact: The name Endeavour was chosen through a competition run in American schools. Children were asked to come up with a name that based on an historic oceangoing research or exploration vessel.

Question: Which vessel was it named after? Who was the captain and where did he explore?

Respond



You are a member of the crew on board the Endeavour, on her maiden voyage in 1992. Write a diary entry about your first day in space. Include lots of detail about the flight and the run up to it.

Discuss
