5. What name do we give to a six-sided shape? (hexagon)
6. Add 5, 2 and 13. (20)
7. Half of 36. (18)
8. What is 8 times 5? (40)
9. Is 35 a multiple of 3? (no)
10. How many metres are there in 1 kilometre? (1000)
